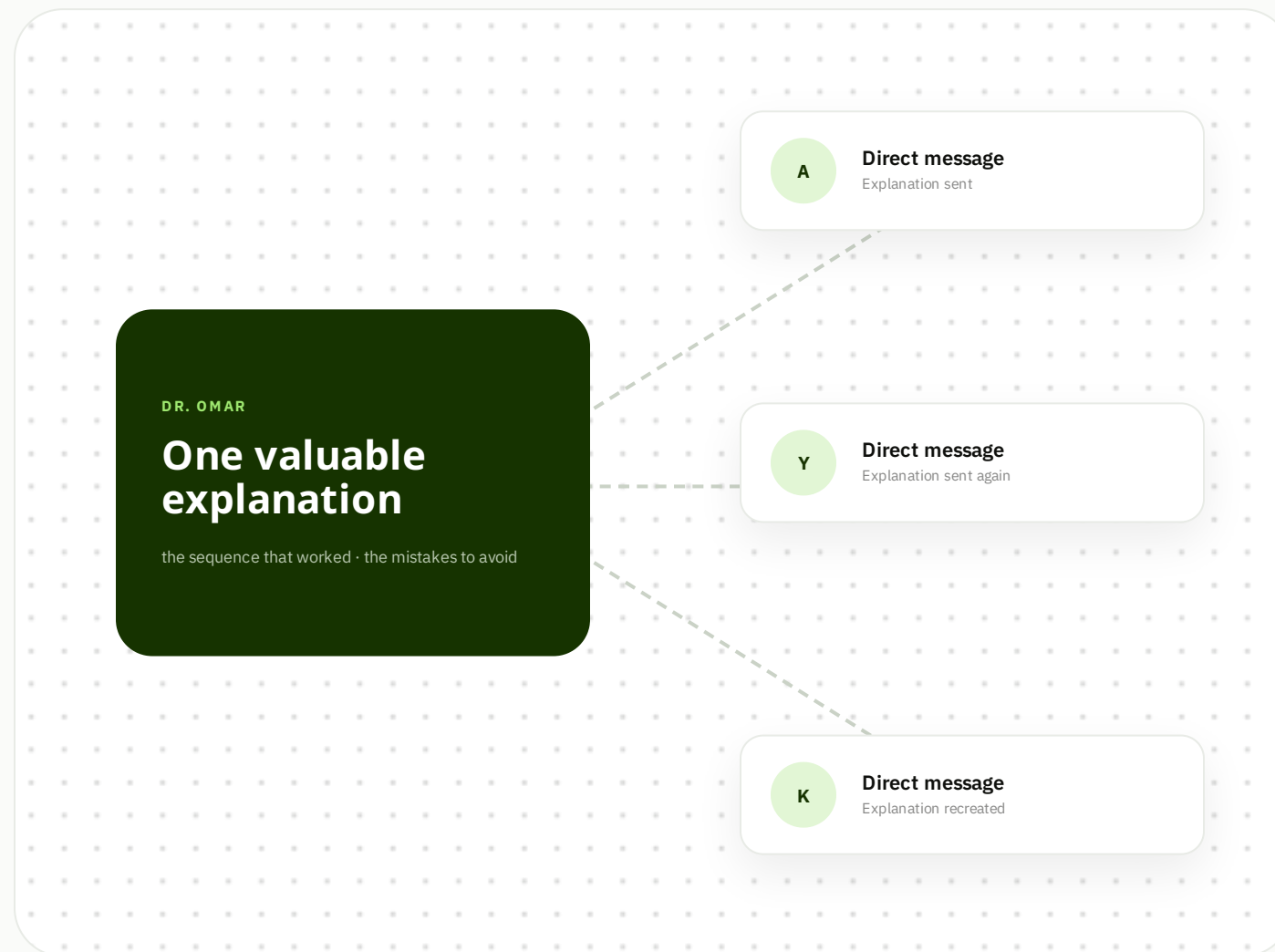
OMAR'S STARTING POINT

His problem is quieter.

"How did you prepare for this exam?"

He sends the same notes. Explains the same mistake.
Recommends the same sequence.

Two beginnings. One pathway.

DR. FAISAL

Do not move everything.

Choose one active exam cohort and one valuable learning loop.

PATHWAY

DR. OMAR

Do not record a giant course.

Choose one learner, one exam, and one useful promise.

ONE LEARNER

ONE PAIN

ONE PROMISE

Keep chat apps as announcement bridges. Move the learning loop first.

Not the chat history.

Each capability appears because it removes one repeated point of friction.

the course in order

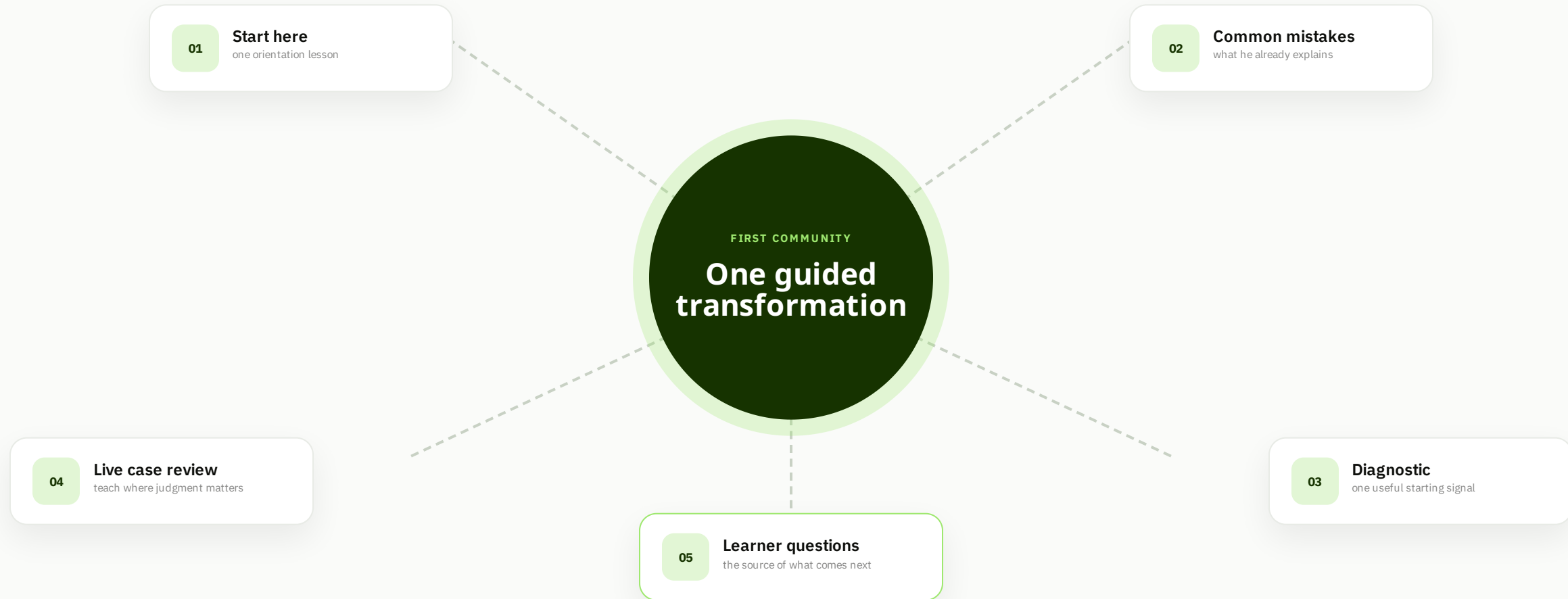

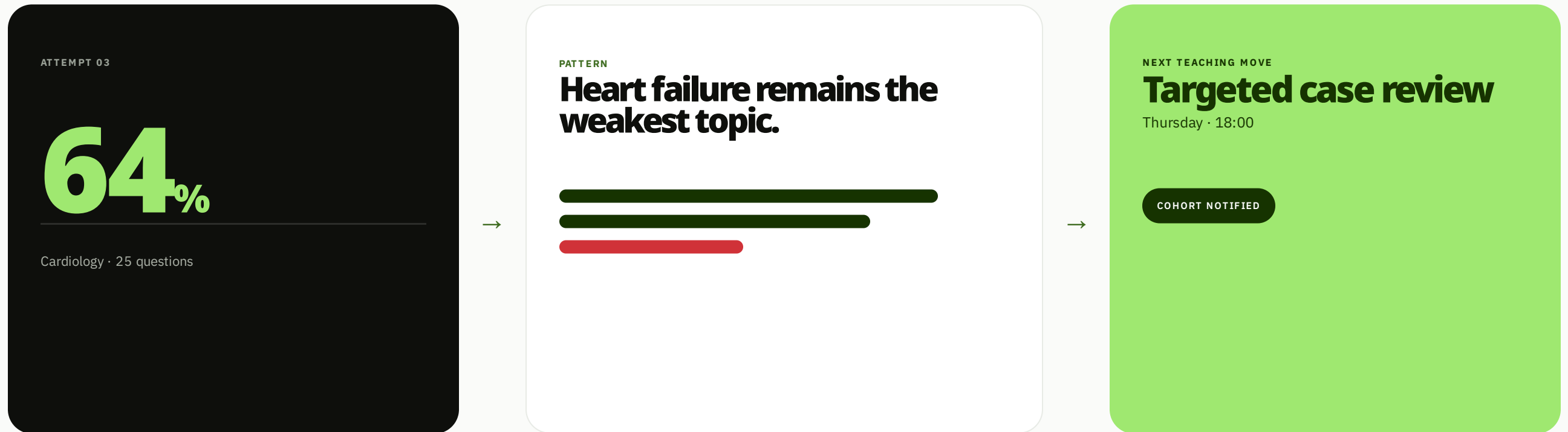
Small enough to start. Complete enough to matter.

A learner finishes an attempt. Faisal can finally see what happens next.

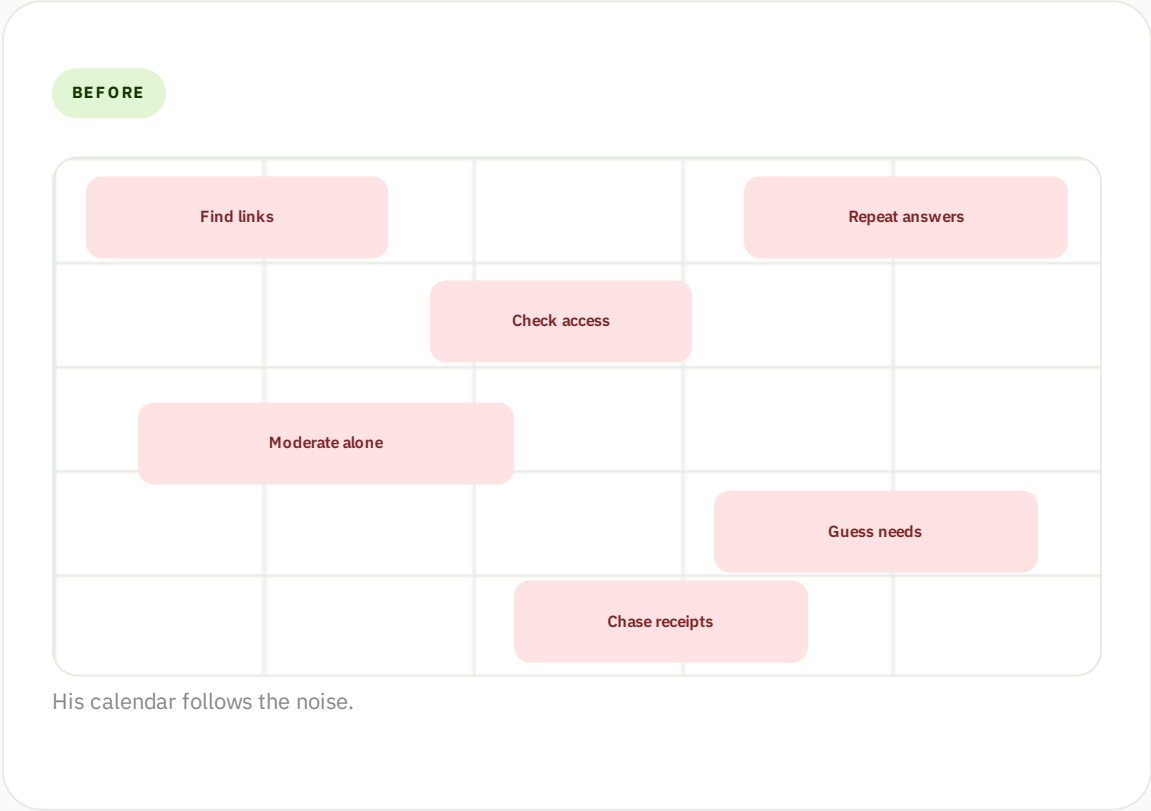


The result becomes a learner action—and a better teaching decision.

His judgment matters more.

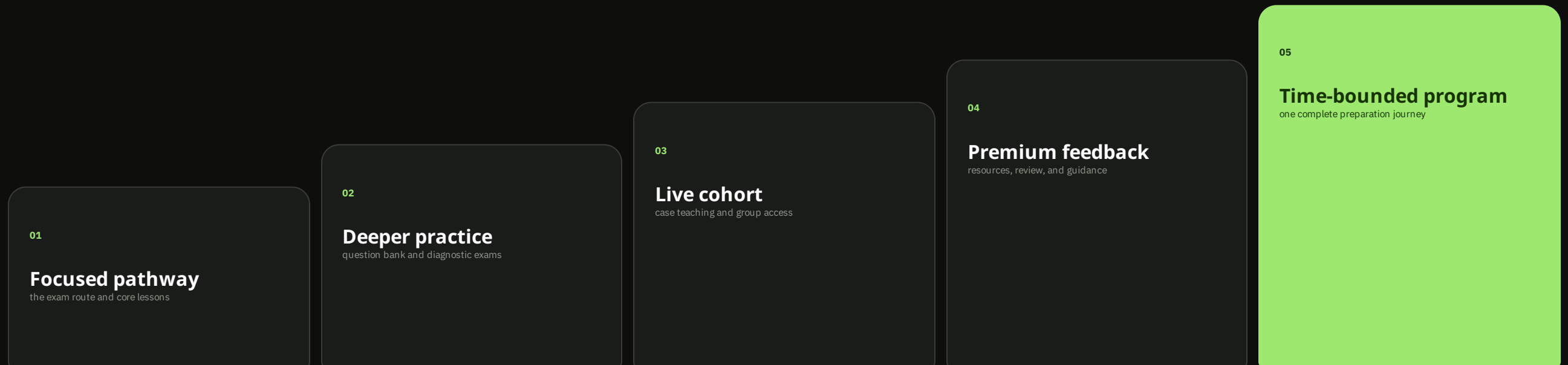
THE CREATOR'S WEEK



— FROM COMMUNITY TO OFFER

Package the outcome— not three generic tiers.

Plans connect clear value to access. The commercial promise is clarity—not guaranteed income.

— THE COMPOUNDING ADVANTAGE

The community becomes more useful because people use it.

In a static course, questions are support cost. Here, they can become the source of the next improvement.



— BEFORE THE FIRST COHORT

Their objections are reasonable.

Controlled adoption is more credible than promising an effortless migration.

“My members will not move.”

Move one valuable cohort and give them a reason to enter.

“It will feel less personal.”

02

Structure removes repeated admin so personal teaching can matter more.

“I do not have a full course.”

03

Start with a pathway, diagnostic, and one live session.

“I am not technical.”

04

Use guided onboarding, migration support, and ready-made structures.
